Mayor Maglio requested a Motion to accept the Bills Lists. Motion by Ms. Wycalek. Second by Mr. Heigis. All in favor.

The following three topics were discussed as potential resolutions:

1. Supporting a Sussex County Consolidated Sussex County School System
2. Shale Gas Development
3. Prisoner Organ Harvesting and Persecution of Falu Dafa in China

These three topics were discussed. It was decided that no further action shall be taken.

In view of the increasing number of unsolicited requests for the Township to adopt resolutions for a variety of causes, the Committee reaffirmed its preference for, and practice of limiting consideration of resolutions to those directly and specifically impacting Walpack Township.

The Group Affidavit – Governing Body Certification – “Enforcement Guidance on the Consideration of Arrest and Conviction Records in Employment Decisions Under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 was signed (3 copies) by Mayor Maglio, Deputy Mayor Heigis, and Committeewoman Wycalek.

The First Reading of the Budget was presented. Mayor Maglio requested a Motion to approve the First Reading of the Budget. Motion by Ms. Wycalek. Second by Mr. Heigis. All in favor.

The Public Hearing and Adoption shall be scheduled for the April 24, 2018 Mayor and Committee meeting.

S2029 – An act concerning the assessment of real property, amending various parts of the statutory law, supplementing chapter 4 of Title 22A of the New Jersey Statutes, and repealing parts of the statutory law was discussed. After discussion, it was determined that complying could be cumbersome for Walpack. The topic is tabled. Township Attorney input shall be requested.

No members of the public were present.

Mayor Maglio requested a Motion to adjourn. Motion by Ms. Wycalek. Second by Mr. Heigis. All in favor.
