Dear Registered Sussex County Voter:

This letter is being sent to you so that you may exercise your right to vote for the electors for President and Vice-President in the upcoming Presidential Election on **November 5, 2024**.

Because your length of residence at your new domicile does not satisfy the voter registration requirements of your new county or state, and as such you were unable to register to vote in your new county or state in time for the upcoming Presidential Election, you are permitted to vote once in your last county or state of residence, providing you were a registered voter in that county or state prior to your move (NJ 19:58-2 etc).

If you moved out of New Jersey ...

You must submit to my office a **Removed Residence Certificate** as well as an **Application for Presidential Ballot** (both described below), which will entitle you to receive and vote a Presidential Ballot by mail:

- A. **REMOVED RESIDENCE CERTIFICATE** (You bring this form to the Commissioner of Registration in the state where you currently live and have them complete and sign it, proving that you are ineligible to vote in that state in the upcoming November Presidential Election.)
- B. **APPLICATION FOR PRESIDENTIAL BALLOT - REMOVED RESIDENT** (You complete this form, showing your current residential information and your former residential information, thereby proving your eligibility to vote one last time as a former registered voter of Sussex County, NJ).

If you moved out of Sussex County but remained in New Jersey, you only need to complete the **APPLICATION FOR PRESIDENTIAL BALLOT - REMOVED RESIDENT**.

INSTRUCTIONS: Once completed, mail form(s) to the Sussex County Clerk's Office. Your application will be reviewed and, if approved, you will be mailed a Presidential Ballot. Please note that your application [and Removed Residence Certificate, if applicable] must be received by the Sussex County Clerk's Office **no later than Monday, Oct. 28th** to ensure enough time for you to receive, vote, and return your ballot to the Board of Election by close of polls on Election Day.

Pursuant to **NJSA 19:58-9**, this **Removed Residence Certificate** must accompany a voter's application for Presidential Ballot in cases where the voter moved out of New Jersey and "removed" to **another state**, and by reason of insufficient time of residence in his new state finds himself ineligible to register to vote in his new state in time for the November General Election.

This **Removed Residence Certificate** and attached **Presidential Ballot Application** shall be mailed to the county clerk in which the ballot is to be voted, in person or by mail, not later than 7 days preceding the election.
